### **Participating Organizations Must Fulfill the Following Criteria:**

- •Be an organization that is engaged in international cooperation or exchange, or a (Japanese) supervising organization/company that promotes such international activities.
- However, supervising organizations/companies must exhibit together with foreign residents related to their organization/company.
- •Also, if an institution engaged in international cooperation or exchange as a part of its business is deemed to be exhibiting as an extension of business activities, it will not be eligible to participate.
- •Be based in Nagasaki Prefecture, and carry out activities mostly or entirely within the prefecture.
- •Have a clearly-designated responsible person who is able to be contacted during the day.
- •Agree to allow the NIA to use photos taken during the event for promotional purposes such as PR magazines and/or posters.

We will limit the number of participating organizations to about 30. If a large number of organizations apply, we will hold a drawing to decide which organizations will participate.
