Application Guidelines for Participating Organizations

We have held the Nagasaki International Festival since 1999 to encourage globalization within local communities and expand grass-roots international exchange, with the help of organizations engaged in international cooperation and exchange. This year will mark the 21st festival. We look forward to an enjoyable day for local people and people of all nationalities living in Nagasaki. We hope that the event will increase understanding of international cooperation, international exchange, and multicultural society, and contribute to the vibrancy of our prefecture.

Event Outline

Time: 11:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Sunday 27th October 2019 (will be held unless there is heavy rain)

Place: Nagasaki Prefectural Office - Entrance Hall, Large Conference Rooms, Outdoor Space.
3-1 Onoue-machi, Nagasaki City.

Participating Organizations Must Fulfill the Following Criteria

- be based in Nagasaki Prefecture, and carry out activities mostly or entirely within the prefecture.
- be a group engaged in international cooperation & exchange
- have a clearly-designated responsible person who is able to be contacted during the day.
- **attend the explanation meeting from 10:00am to noon on Saturday 3rd August** at the Large Conference Room C (大会議室 C), Nagasaki Prefectural Office. (3-1 Onoue-machi, Nagasaki City)
- agree to allow the NIA to use photos taken during the event for promotional purposes such as posters.

Ways to Participate

Ways for your organization to participate include but are not limited to: exhibition stalls (i.e. a display about the organization's activities), flea markets, stalls selling fair trade goods & handicrafts from overseas, 'try-out' corners (i.e. trying on traditional clothing), and stalls selling international food.

Number of Organizations

We will limit the number of participating organizations to about 35. If a large number of organizations apply, we will hold a drawing to decide which organizations will participate.

Participation Fee

- Participation is free of charge
- However, if you wish to sell any food other than prepackaged food, the following charges apply:
Application fee to the Nagasaki City Public Health Division for a temporary business permit: **¥2000** for each 'line of business'. For more information on 'lines of business', see the document "How to Participate".
